**Beckstoffer To Kalon
Vineyard, Oakville**

Color: Deep red cherry with touches of magenta and violet on the rim

On the nose: Fresh cut herbs with touches of leather, chocolate, BBQ meat, tomato stems lingering on raspberries, gummy bears, grenadine, cranberries, sweet cinnamon

On the palate: Silky entrance evolving on a soft but fresh palate, with touches of red fruit ripe strawberries, juniper and hints of cassis

Nestled at the edge of the Mayacamas Mountains in the center of Napa Valley, To Kalon receives just enough morning fog and full day sun to produce Cabernet Sauvignon grapes with complex layers of cassis, wild berries, licorice and spice. Firm, well-integrated tannins support these rich flavors.

Varietal: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Fermentation: 100% barrel fermentation

22 months 100% French Oak;

80% New French Oak

Case Production: 175
