Color: Ruby red with touches of violet on the rim On the nose: Baked bread with touches of cedar, sea air, cranberry, tomato sauce with black pepper, roast beef, chocolate, marmite and fruit pit.

On the palate: Soft velvety entrance lingering on cherry, black currant, lingering on juniper, lavender, candy and cumin

Dr. Crane is situated on the west side of St Helena which has gravelly loamy soils and a very warm climate. Of all the sites, Dr. Crane is the warmest, and has the most extracted style. Because of this the wine has a very rich and velvety palate with candied fruit on the finish.
