Beckstoffer Missouri Hopper Vineyard, Oakville

Color: Deep brilliant red with touches of bright red on the rim

On the nose: Saw dust, cigar box, cedar with spices, roasted almond, paprika, Espelette chili, blackberries, blueberries with hints of clay and green bean.

On the palate: Balanced entrance with soft and silky tannins, fresh acidity, lingering on pineapple, guava and chocolate

Missouri Hopper is a spectacular vineyard situated in the hourglass of the Napa Valley, which gives it a cooler climate than neighboring To Kalon Vineyard due to the influence of the bay.

Missouri Hopper yields

Cabernet Sauvignon that has a balance of ripeness and power with finesse and elegance. We believe this is one of the most exceptional sites Napa Valley has to offer.
