On the nose: Crushed strawberries and black cherry with crushed rock and a hint of tarragon and smoked paprika.

On the palate: Entrance of milk chocolate covered espresso beans with elderberry and blackberry preserves evolving on cassis with granular tannins and tonic.

Nestled at the edge of the Mayacamas
Mountains in the center of Napa Valley, To
Kalon receives just enough morning fog and
full day sun to produce Cabernet Sauvignon
grapes with complex layers of cassis, wild berries, licorice and spice. Firm, well-integrated
tannins support these rich flavors.
