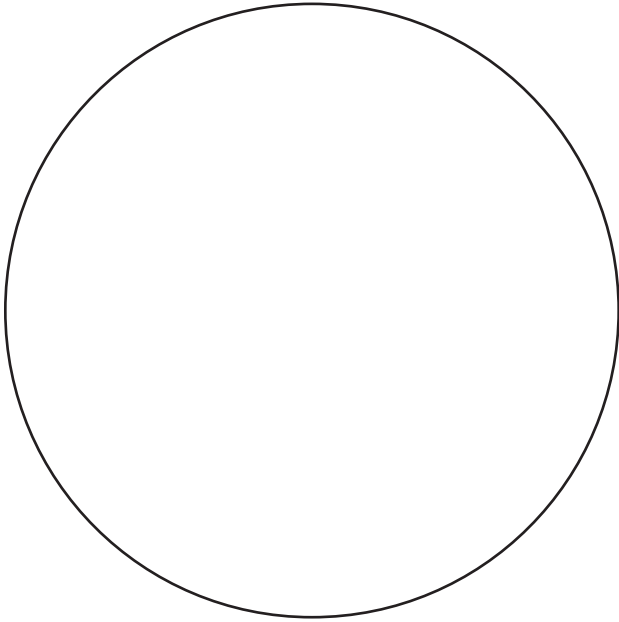


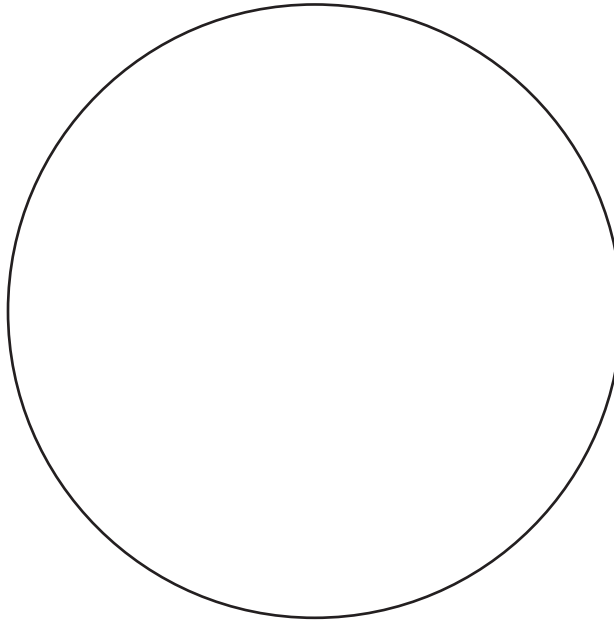

Cabernet Franc



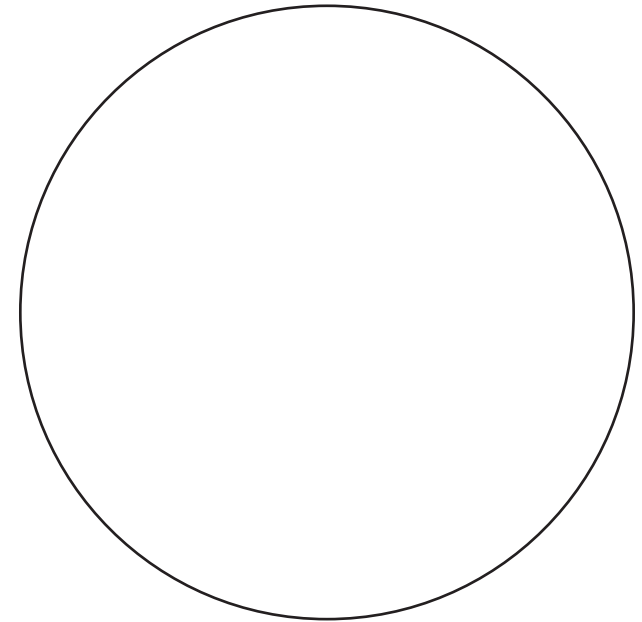
Sleeping Lady

- Yountville AVA, closest in proximity to the Bay so coolest site
- Alluvial soil from the Mayacamas Mountain Bench, located west of Hwy 29
- East to West vineyard orientation, slightly sloped for drainage, clone 214
- Wine DNA: Elegance and balance with concentration



Beckstoffer To Kalon

- Oakville AVA, warm site but morning fog and late afternoon sun sets behind Mayacamas to protect natural acidity.
- Approximately 60% loam and 40% clay
- Row orientation is close together to promote competition for nutrients, therefore smaller more concentrated berries.
- Wine DNA: Structured with granular tannins



Stagecoach

- Pritchard Hill, 1,500 feet in elevation above the fog line, cool site with excellent air circulation, creating perfect small berry mountain-side ripening
- Volcanic, rocky and Iron rich soil
- Block D5, West to Southwest facing northernmost block of Stagecoach.
- Wine DNA: Intensity, power and acidity
