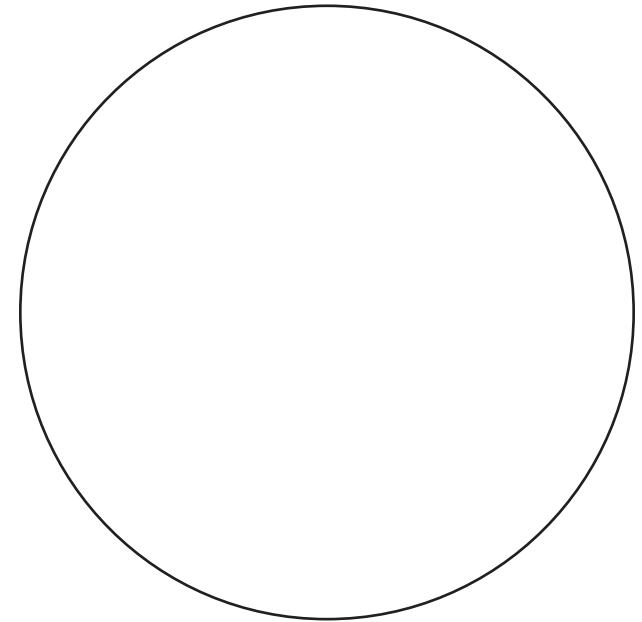
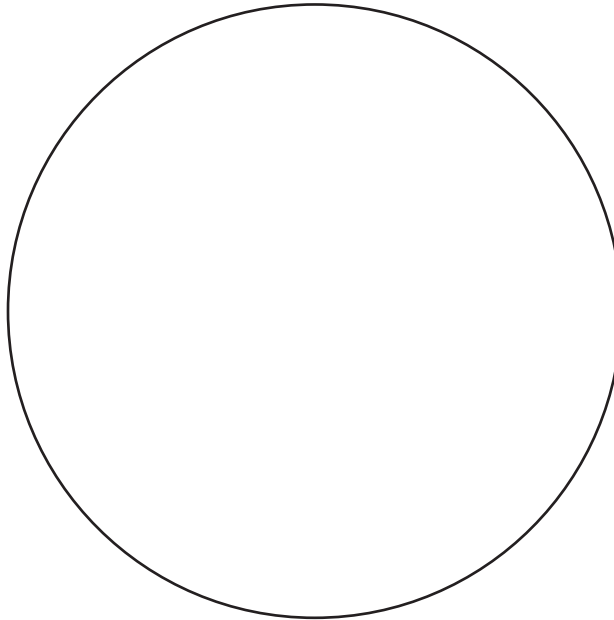
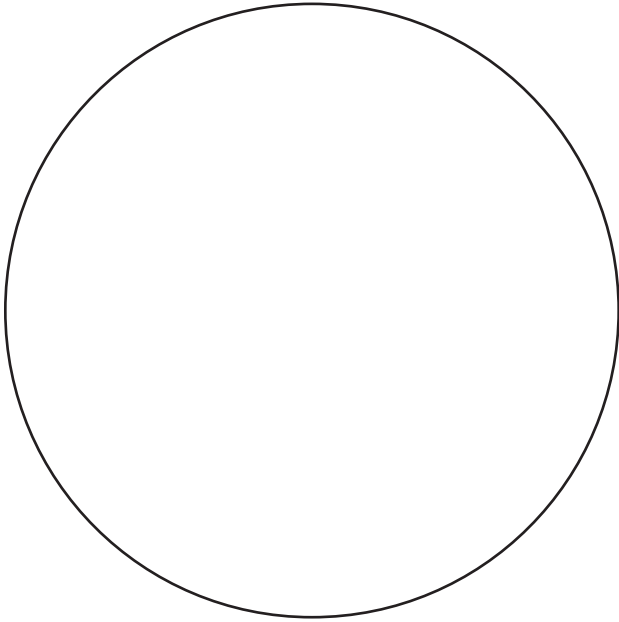

Beckstoffer Missouri Hopper

- Oakville AVA, located in the hourglass of the Valley with fog and air conditioning from the Bay protecting acidity.
- The soil is predominately clay with a small amount of loam.
- Wine DNA: balance of ripeness and power, finished with finesse and elegance. Missouri Hopper yields Cabernet Sauvignon with a balance of ripeness and power, finished with finesse and elegance.

Beckstoffer To Kalon

- Oakville AVA, receives just enough morning fog and full warm day of sun to protect acidity while maximize concentration
- Approximately 60% loam and 40% clay
- Wine DNA: Structured with granular tannins

Beckstoffer Dr. Crane

- St. Helena AVA, warmest of the sites, located on the west side of St. Helena
- Old river bed with gravelly loam, reflecting heat
- Wine DNA: Extracted with a sexy, rich and velvety palate.
